You and your advertising company have been chosen to develop an advertising campaign that will encourage tourists to visit a certain biome. You will need to find out about the types of things a person could see or do in that biome and then advertise them in a way that makes people want to go see it for themselves.

Your advertising company will create three parts for the campaign:

- 1. Travel poster
- 2. Brochure
- 3. 45-second commercial

The brochure should include:

- 1. A title page with a picture and a phrase or slogan to get people's interest
- 2. A map showing where on Earth your biome is located
- 3. A 4-6 sentence description of the biome in general
- 4. Names of at least three types of animal life, including at least one picture
- 5. Names of at least three types of plant life, including at least one picture
- 6. Names of at least three cities or specific places in your biome
- 7. Names of at least three different types of landforms found in your biome. Give specific examples. Include their locations.
- 8. Examples of the types of activities that can be done in your biome (at least two).
- 9. Describe a hotel where people could stay in your biome. Name the hotel. Explain at least three things that your hotel has that makes it more comfortable for tourists to stay in your biome. (For example, in a desert biome, a hotel would have to have plenty of fresh water for its guests to drink because the desert doesn't provide much water for them.)

The poster and commercial should include some of the same information as the brochure. Choose what you think is most important or most interesting. Your commercial will be presented to the class.
